Discover is our Learning Management System (LMS)


The most common LMSs are Canvas and Blackboard. These are used by colleges and schools but there are several others. Ours is Docebo, which we call Discover.

If you see something else come up like Production Academy, it means that your profile has not been updated since the migration so please contact me





Learning Plans



Software, Procedures, Pipeline tools, Workflows, Art Techniques, etc.


Courses


